Almost French wants children to be safe, happy and empowered. We support and respect all children, as well as our staff and volunteers.

Almost French is committed to the safety, participation and empowerment of all children.

Almost French has legal and moral obligations to contact authorities when we are worried about a child's safety, which we follow rigorously.

Almost French adheres and follows the 7 child safe standards and the reportable conduct scheme starting in January.

Almost French is committed to preventing child abuse and identifying risks early, and removing and reducing these risks.

Almost French has strict procedures of recruitment practices for all staff and volunteers.

Almost French support and respect all children, as well as our staff and volunteers. We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from a culturally and/or linguistically diverse backgrounds, and to providing a safe environment for children with a disability.

Almost French has specific policies, procedures and training in place that support our leadership team, staff and volunteers to achieve these commitments.
